Purpose

This policy outlines the rules and guidelines for administrators and members of our Facebook Group. It ensures a positive and respectful environment for all participants.

1. Group Theme, Purpose and Rules

- The group theme is **Tasmanian climbing and climbing community**.
- The purpose of this group is to enable good communication for the Tasmanian climbing community.
- Rules of this group:
 - Maintain a respectful and constructive tone in discussions. Posts and comments should avoid being strongly divisive or inflammatory.
 - This group is public-facing. Content should be suitable for an audience which could include external parties, e.g. first nation people, landowners, media.
 - This group is public-facing. **Posts which have the potential to jeopardise climbing access are not permitted.**
 - No hate speech, harassment, discrimination, or personal attacks.
 - No selling (instead refer to: Tassie Outdoor Gear Market).
 - No spam or self-promotion.
 - Stay on-topic, relevant to the group's theme.

2. Admin Roles and Responsibilities

- Admins should:
 - Monitor posts and comments.
 - Enforce group rules
 - Address member concerns promptly.

3. Content Moderation

- Admins can:
 - Remove posts or comments that violate group rules.
 - Warn, restrict or remove members who repeatedly or grossly violate rules.
 - Encourage positive discussions and engagement.

4. Collaboration with Other Admins

- Coordinate with other admins to ensure consistent enforcement of rules.
- Share insights and best practices.
